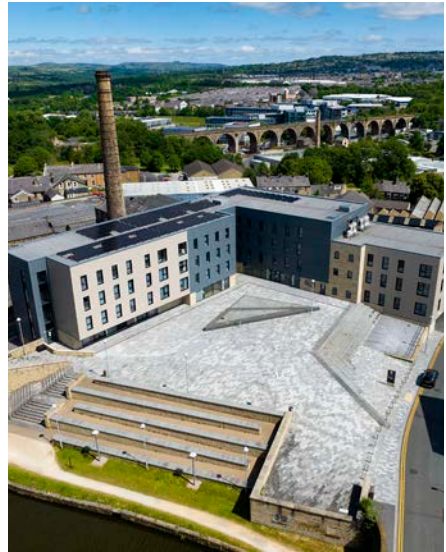

Accommodation

There's something special about coming to stay in University accommodation, especially if it's your first time away from home.

As well as the convenience of being located on campus, you'll be part of a welcoming halls community, where you'll meet new friends and socialise together - sharing experiences and making memories. It's important to us that it feels like your home from home.

Sandygate Halls

Sandygate has 136 en-suite bedrooms, within 29 flats. Most flats have 4 or 5 bedrooms.

All bedrooms are modern and of a good size, featuring a small double bed, notice boards, study desk and chair, chest of drawers, wardrobe and a waste bin. Each en-suite has a personal shower, wash basin and toilet.

Each flat has a communal kitchen, which is well-equipped with a dining table and chairs, cooker, fridges, freezers, microwave, kettle, toaster, and plenty of cupboard space.

There is a student hub social area, which features flexible working space and comfortable seating and a flat screen TV.

How to view: Starting at 10.00am, guided tours of Sandygate Halls take place every 30 minutes starting from the main entrance of the building. The last tour begins at 1.30pm.

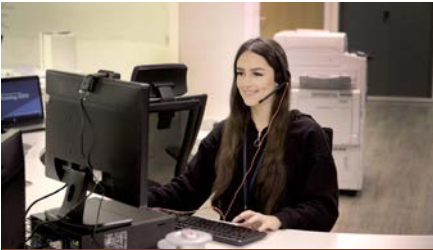

Newtown Mill

In 2024 we will be continuing our expansion in Burnley with the opening of Newtown Mill.

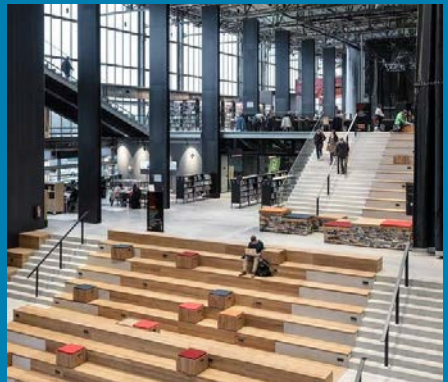
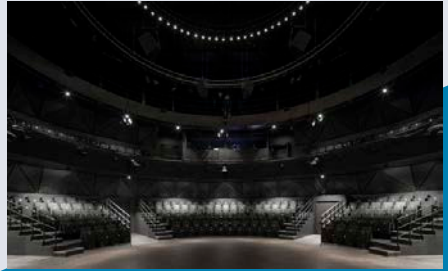
Newtown Mill was an empty Victorian mill but is currently being reconstructed into a new state-of-the-art teaching building – and students starting next year will be the first to use the new facilities.

The renovation of the former industrial building is being delivered by Burnley Borough Council's joint venture with Brierfield's Barnfield Developments using part of the £19.9m Levelling Up Fund cash obtained from government.

The new 4-story building will include;

- 2 x Lecture theatres
- 7 x Teaching rooms
- 13 x Seminar rooms
- 2 x Psychology labs
- 2 x Computer rooms
- Business Interaction Suite
- Meeting rooms and focus spaces
- Wellness and Counselling rooms
- A large café
- Staff offices
